

English

In English we will be using 'Tales told in Tents' written by Sally Pomme Clayton. The book is a collection of traditional tales from Central Asia. The children will be working on their written work as well as their delivery and presentation of poetry.

History

Our topic this term is Cradles of Civilisation. In this unit the pupils will be learning about why historical civilisations flourished and why location was so important.

Geography

The focus this term is Mountains. The children will investigate different mountain ranges as well as exploring what it is like to live in the mountains.

Computing

In computing we will be focusing on Online Safety and Spreadsheets. Children will be using purple mash to work on their programming and Times Table Rockstars to improve on their mathematics.

PE

The topics this term are:

Science

This term in Science we will be learning about Light. The children will investigate what light is, and what happens when there is no light. From this, they will understand how shadows are formed. The children will also learn about how light is reflected.

Cradles of Civilisation

Latin

The topic title this term is Food Glorious Food. The children will be learning about the delicacies of the Roman Empire and link this with their understanding of animal names.

RHE

The focus in RHE is Courtesy and Manners. The children will understand what diversity is, as well as discussing personal and private boundaries within friendships and wider relationships and who to talk to if they are feeling worried.

Maths

Our Maths topics this term are Addition and Subtraction followed by Multiplication and Division. The children will consolidate their fluency skills before applying their understanding in a wider range of contexts such as word problems and problem-solving. By the end of the term, the children will be confident in using and applying all four operations.

Art and Design

This term we will be looking at art using faces. This includes how to draw faces accurately and making our own face masks!

Religious Education

In R.E. this term the children will be learning about Sikhism. More specifically, we will learn about how the religion of Sikhism began, what the 5Ks are and why the Amrit ceremony is important to Sikhs. We will then spend a few weeks discussing how Christians prepare for Christmas.

Music

This term's focus is composition and performance. We will also learn a range of Christmas Carols.
